Re: **Definitions** 

Even though this is contrary to many within the aviation community including the FAA, I want to clarify for everyone the proper usage of the terms "Experimental", "Airworthy", and "Unairworthy" here at Sensenich Propeller Manufacturing Company.

An "airworthy" propeller is any propeller that meets the minimum requirements set in either the latest Sensenich repair manual or the propeller's Type Certificate Data Sheet.

An 'unairworthy" propeller is any propeller that does not meet the minimum requirements set in either the latest Sensenich repair manual or the propeller's Type Certificate Data Sheet.

An 'experimental" propeller is an "airworthy" propeller that has not yet been Type Certified. An "experimental" propeller cannot be an "unairworthy" propeller.
